Form CC - Explanation

Form CC is very important to the National Organization and Your Chapter. It is important because:

- It allows your chapter to plan in advance and make sure that you are focused and organized. By identifying important dates and deadlines, the chapter members will know when things must be accomplished (paperwork submitted, bills paid, build homecoming float, party set up, etc.) and will be able to work together to achieve them. You will also know when to recognize people for significant accomplishments (those who are graduating).
- It identifies important academic times which should not be interfered with (in other words, don't plan social events during finals, etc.).
- It helps in planning and promoting alumni relations, a social calendar, and national relations.
- It enables the National Organization to provide better services to the chapter (we can schedule events at times that are beneficial to everyone, and the consultant and chapter can mutually agree upon a visit date).

Important Information:

- An academic year is unlike a calendar year; it typically starts in the fall and concludes in the spring or early summer, e.g. the 2001-02 Academic Year.
- When it states from or between on the form, we are looking for a range of dates, e.g. November 5- November 10.
- *If you are a semester school, you only need to fill out information for the Fall and Spring terms. If there is a summer term at your university and your chapter functions during that time, please attach a sheet of paper with all of the relevant dates.*

This form should be turned in to the National Office within two weeks of the start of your chapter's academic year!
